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Asking "have you been to the toilet?" five times before leaving the house.



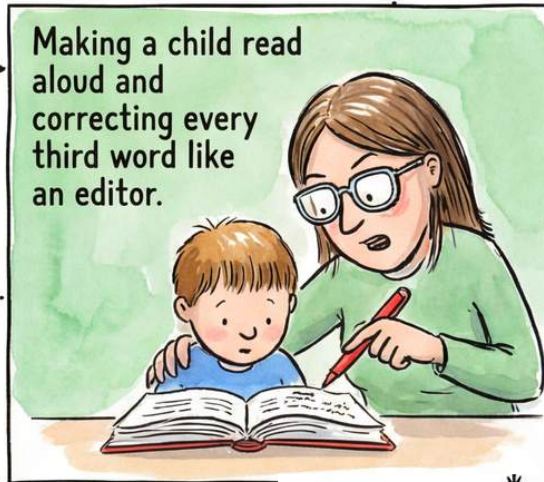
Lifting a sleeping child's head to swap a bloodied tooth for coins like a stealth burglar.

Making a child read aloud and correcting every third word like an editor.



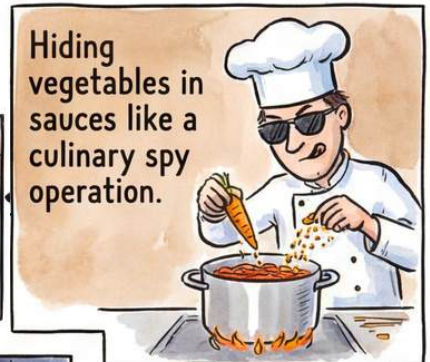
Saying "just one more bite" at least ten times per meal.

Hiding vegetables in sauces like a culinary spy operation.



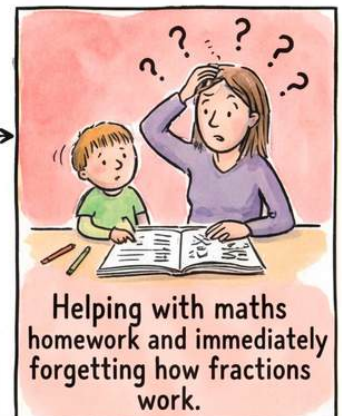
Saying "we'll see" when they absolutely mean "no".
